We look year on year at areas of strength and set aspirational targets for improving other areas to match the cohort of children accordingly. For this academic year improvements in outcomes for higher achieving pupils at the end of KS2 will be a focus for continued improvement.

After careful analysis of the results the following areas for development are:

- KS1 Writing to meet the increasing demands of the new curriculum.
- KS2 Maths to meet the increasing demands of the new curriculum.
- Whole school development of Science learning to meet the requirements of the new curriculum.
- Maintaining and developing reading across the school at higher levels.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the children, staff, parents and governors for their dedication and hard work in achieving these results and look forward to another successful year in 2015/16.
