Choose one of the photos below. Mind map vocabulary relating to it, including sights, sounds, smells, etc. Some questions are included for you to consider as you plan what to write. Develop these ideas to write a setting description inspired by the photo. Try to include a range of punctuation, a variety of sentence structures and ambitious vocabulary. If this inspires you, you could continue to write the narrative or find another picture on the internet to write about.

What will you see, hear and feel during a storm? Did it occur suddenly or build up slowly? Is anyone in the lighthouse?



What happened to the boat? How long has it been capsized? Did anyone fall overboard? Is it sunrise or sunset? What is floating in the water?
