Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Whole School Trip to Chatsworth House – 12th July

On **12th July** we will be taking the whole school on a trip to Chatsworth House in Derbyshire. The visit will form part of our 'This Is Us' summer term topic as the children will be learning about the significant role that Chatsworth has played in Derbyshire through history.

Our Key Stage 1 pupils will be taken on a guided tour of the farm and will also be participate in a tractor ride. They will have access to the adventure playground over the lunch period and they will also complete some learning tasks based on the Chatsworth gardens in the afternoon.

Our Key Stage 2 pupils will be taken on a guided tour of the mansion during the morning before completing learning tasks in the Chatsworth gardens in the afternoon. They will also have access to the adventure playground in the afternoon.

Children should arrive in school at the normal time wearing Eggington School uniform. They will need to bring a drink and a packed lunch for the visit. Reception and Key Stage 1 children will need to indicate on the attached form if they require a packed lunch to be provided for them by school or whether they will bring their own lunch. Children should also bring sun hats and sun protection cream in the event of hot sunny weather or a waterproof coat in the event of wet weather.

Transport to the trip will be provided both to and from Chatsworth House. The coach will be departing promptly at 9.05am in the morning in order for us to arrive at the venue in time and enjoy the full day's programme. **Please ensure your child arrives at school no later than 8.55am** on the day of the trip. The coach will return in time for normal collection from school at 3.20pm.

We respectfully request that parents and carers make a voluntarily contribution of £10 per pupil to put towards the transport and visit itself. This cost for parents and carers has already been heavily subsidised thanks to a substantial and generous donation by the PTA. Many thanks to them. However, if we do not receive enough contributions from parents and carers towards the visit, then the trip will not be able to go ahead. Thank you for your understanding and support.
