### Dinner Money

For parents with children in KS2 (years 3, 4 and 5) who wish to pay dinner money half termly the amount due up to the summer holidays is £74.10. For children in Year 6 it will be £70.20 (allowing for the induction days at John Port).

School dinners are £9.75 per week. Cheques (any amount £10 and over), should be made payable to Derbyshire County Council.

Please make sure your cash is in an envelope with your child's name on.
