World Book Week 14th March - 18th March

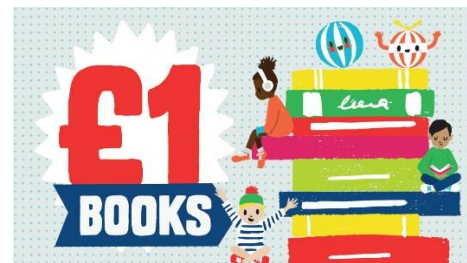
Lots of fun activities taking place around the theme of modern British Authors.
