Pupil Questionnaire April 2016 Responses and Actions.

Today the children completed the pupil questionnaire. 63 pupils participated (1 child=1.5%) The overall responses are as follows:

Question 2 and Question 7: The children discussed how at playtimes a few children can get a bit rough. As a result new games and a buddy stop will be discussed with the school council to give a fuller range of activities. Also, behaviour expectations have again been highlighted and positive behaviour will be rewarded.

Question 6: The vast majority of children who disagreed felt that they got too much homework. We discussed that reading, number bonds/times tables and Spag.com were a regular short burst expectation and that any other homework was given to support learning and had an appropriate timescale for completion.

Question 11: The children felt that sometimes they were always told how to get better and wanted a 'well done' day. The staff will look at this idea.

Question 12: The children suggested more teachers, more male teachers, more classes and a bigger site as ways to improve the school.
