Behaviour system, School Rules and Rewards/ Sanctions

Following the response to the pupil questionnaire where some children stated that behaviour could be better, we discussed which aspects of behaviour need to improve.

Will: Sometimes some children can be a bit chatty and talk when the teacher is talking.

Eben: Sometimes children talk over the top of teachers.

Maisie: In the playground children some children don't look after the equipment or don't use it correctly. It is mainly the little ones.

Alice: Not long after we get new equipment, it ends up getting broken.

Mr Kitching said that the children will be reminded in assembly about how to respect the equipment and use it correctly. The children suggested that pupils should be banned from using equipment if it is not used properly. Will thought a strike system would be a good idea.

We then discussed the current school rules. The pupils were a bit unsure about what they were and they thought it would be a good idea to ask each class to think of new school rules that everybody could follow.

The school council thought that the idea of team point cards was good because they liked it when they used to have star charts. However, they were concerned that some children might put on extra points that had not been awarded. Mr Kitching said that maybe one of the new school rules could be 'Be Honest.'



The pupils said that they use the traffic light system as a sanction but they said that often when they were put on Red, nothing else happened. They thought that it would be a good idea if someone put on red should lose their break time or be sent to the Headteacher.

The children liked the idea of earning Golden time for good things they have done as a class and that they should be able to choose what they want to do.

Playground Buddies

The school council thought the idea of having Playground buddies was good. They suggested the idea of having a place to go to if you were feeling left out and then the Playground buddies would come and help you join in with a game.

Musical Performances

The children thought it would be a good idea if musicians signed up to when they wanted to perform some music in assembly.

AOB

The school council wanted to raise more money through the 'School in A Bag' scheme.

The school council requested Egginton's Got Talent to be reintroduced.

Actions:

School Councillors to ask each class what they think the new school rules should be (Charlotte and Alice to ask Robins).

School Councillors to ask classes about new rewards and sanctions to be used to encourage behaviour.

Mr Kitching to look into buying Playground Buddies clothing and setting up a rota. Mr Kitching to buy a sign for the playground for people to go to if they were feeling lonely or left out.

Mr Kitching to look into School in the Bag scheme and ask the teachers about it.

Mr Kitching to ask the staff about Egginton's got talent and look into setting it up.

Mr Kitching to set up a musician rota for assembly.
