Children regularly use different websites and apps from their parents, and it can be hard to keep up in this everchanging digital world.

Check out this video from parentsprotect.co.uk... Our overall attendance for this year has been 95.93% which is slightly above the government target of 95%.

If your child's attendance has dropped below the government recommended target, you will receive a letter indicating their current percentage. If it is 90% or less, this is considered 'Persistent Absenteeism' by DCC.
